 - c. Tech Update: Ms. Herold is working on a Cyber Security Certification. We implemented a device management system. All our devices will be barcoded when they return to the students. Graduation will be livestreamed and live on channel 22. There will be 3 different cameras with 3 different angles. The Parade starts at 4:15 P.M and Graduation is at 6:00 P.M.
