## Board of Education Special Meeting Wednesday, June 16, 2021, 5:00 P.M. Migeon Ave/Zoom

## **Minutes**

- 1. Call to Order: 5:02 P.M.
- 2. Roll Call: Ms. Cappabianca, Mr. Corey, Ms. Hoehne, Mr. Kissko, Mr. Maniccia, Mr. Eucalitto, Ms. Fappiano, Ms. Richardson, Ms. Todor, Ms. DePretis (remote)

- 3. Approval of Agenda: Mr. Corey made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Mr. Eucalitto. All in favor.
- 4. Discussion on 2021/2022 Budget: Mr. Arum summarized his meeting with the Mayor. He reviewed the proposal he presented to her. Only the turf field replacement is included in our capital budget. Mr. Arum presented the budget to satisfy the city's request of a 0.0012304% budget increase to the budget or \$76,932,898.00. The Chair stated that we do not need permission to spend our surplus. "We have given it back to the City each year in good faith, but we are not required to do that." The board reviewed e-mails sent from the Mayor regarding the 0% budget increase. The BOE surplus from this year will pay for a portion of projected expenditures that were cut from the budget to reach the budget allocation set by the BOF. Additionally, the board was not in favor of putting the TMS roof up for referendum, since the State (OPM) said the City can include the TMS roof in their American Rescue Act Plan (ARPA). The mill rate would not change if this occurred. The board can request a special meeting with the City to discuss the allocation of funds and work collaboratively together. The board has a right to request that the 2% of the ECS money come directly to the BOE. The board is voting tonight on the budget. The board will propose a joint meeting with BOE and BOF for next Wednesday at 5:00 P.M. and then the BOE will schedule a subsequent meeting.
