Mr. Vergaro makes the following motion in open session:

That the Torrington Board of Education finds, based on the evidence in the record that the student who is the subject of this hearing did, on or about June 1, 2017, engage in the following conduct: possessed deadly weapons on school grounds. This conduct endangered persons and property, was seriously disruptive of the educational process, violated publicized policies of the Board of Education and

constitutes an expellable offense.

The Board further moved:

That the student who is the subject of this hearing shall be expelled from the Torrington Public Schools for one calendar year from the date of the incident, June 1, 2017. During the period of expulsion the student who is the subject of this hearing shall not be allowed to enter any school property and/or participate in any school sponsored events and activities, except to participate in the alternative educational program, as determined by the Administration.

Seconded by J. Richardson. All in favor.
